1. A child means anyone below the age of 16 years.
2. In the case of the purchase of an Exclusive Right of Burial and all other purchases excluding Interment Fees, Resident fees are calculated on the residency of the purchaser. In the case of Interment Fees, Resident and Non-Resident fees are calculated on the residency of the deceased.
3. A child shall be defined as a resident if a parent thereof is/has been resident as defined in 5 below
4. A reserved plot must be marked by a plaque, the supply and installation of which will be managed by the Town Council
5. A Resident is defined as anyone who has been a resident of Great Dunmow (as defined by the parish boundaries) for 5 of the preceding 15 years.
