

GAMING BUS EVENT

Wednesday 26th October

All the small print:

The event runs from 1-5pm in the Foakes Hall Car Park on Wednesday 26th October. This will mean that the Car Park will be closed from the evening before (Tuesday 25th October) to keep it clear of vehicles on the day. Parents dropping off on the Wednesday afternoon will have to find an alternative place to park.

The event has been risk assessed and is suitable for senior school age children whether they are noobs or pros. The age range of the games will be 3+ to 16+. Gaming bus staff are DBS checked but are not responsible for the children, they are there for technical support. When booking tickets parental permission to attend is a given. There will be no food or drink allowed to be consumed on the bus.

The afternoon has been split into 20 minute time slots to play **inside** the bus. This is to enable as many students as possible to get the full experience of the event.

1 student = 1 time slot, up to 45 time slots every 20 minutes. Make sure you book your time slot with your friends. Each bus can accommodate 15 people at one time and we have three buses coming to the car park.

Arrive in good time and bring your ticket with you, know which game you want to play when you arrive to make the best use of the time. Wrist bands and ink stamps will be used to identify the gamers.

The buses can run in all weathers, but if there is heavy rain or high winds the games on the outside of the bus will not be available.

Each bus has:

- 3 Xbox series X consoles
- 3 Playstation 5's
- 2 Racing simulators
- 2 Nintendo switches

Games available are the latest: Fifa 23, Fortnite, Gran Turismo, Forza Horizon 5, Minecraft, Gang Beasts, Halo, Star Wars Battle Front, Spiderman Miles Morales, Need for Speed, Apex Legends, Street Fighter and more...



Outside of the buses there are other games which can be played which are not controlled by specific booked times. These games include:

Mario Kart, Just Dance, Karaoke and VR.



Inside Foakes Hall there will be two additional arcade machines, each two player.

Refreshments will be provided in the Talberd Room – free of charge.

In the hall we are also hosting other organisations. 1Life will be arranging games of 'Tennis Volley Challenge' and 'Football Tennis' with lots of similar games on offer.

We are expecting other organisations to be attending to advise on personal safety and discuss recruitment and roles within those various organisations.
